Lacrosse Victoria Flexible Uniform Policy

Lacrosse Victoria recognises that in circumstances where religious and cultural beliefs conflict with Lacrosse Victoria's standard dress code, that modification to the standard uniform will be accommodated where possible (e.g. where safety and other playing requirements can be met). In addition wherever possible our clubs will consider flexibility in uniforms to encourage the participation of women and girls.

This may include, but is not restricted to:

- less restrictive, body hugging attire
- the wearing of traditional head scarf or turban
- the wearing of leggings or tracksuits to cover legs
- the wearing of long sleeve top to cover arms

Lacrosse Victoria requires that headscarves be tied but are not to be fastened with any pins or sharp objects. Colours of headscarves or other garments must be black or in accordance with, or resemble the official colours of Lacrosse Victoria or the member's Club.
