Finals Allocations

The Chief Referee (CR) of the Australian Lacrosse Referees Association (Victorian Branch) Incorporated (ALRAV) is responsible for the allocations of Officials to all 'finals' games for State League, Division 1, 2 and 3, and to junior completion games from the U15 age group upward.

The CR will take advise from any party he/she sees fit to assist in making the allocations. These parties may include, but are not limited to, the Assessing (Technical Delegate) group, the coaching fraternity or Lacrosse Victoria.

The CR will make the final decision and as such will also be responsible for relaying that decision to the Officials concerned along with any justification for the allocations made.

Bendigo Allocations

Allocations to games played in Bendigo by the Bendigo LC will be undertaken by the Allocations Officer (AO) of ALRAV.

The AO will take into account the weekly activities of the officiating group, and in the first instance allocate to Bendigo those referees who do not undertake two games (junior/senior or senior/senior) per Saturday.
