Noel McDonald Award

The “Noel McDonald Award” is an annual award presented by ALRA Victoria (ALRAV) to encourage the participation of one up and coming referee at an Australian Lacrosse Association (ALA) National Tournament/Championship.

The recipient of the Noel McDonald Award will receive an amount of \$300 as development support of men’s lacrosse officiating in practical way. The money shall be funded from ALRAV general revenue for that year.

The recipient shall be a guest of ALRAV at the AGM and be presented with a certificate by Noel as recognition.

To be eligible for the Noel McDonald award, an individual must not have previously officiated at an ALA National Tournament/Championship.

Suitable candidates may include:

- A current player with an interest or involvement in officiating and a desire to “try it”.
- A parent of a player who is interested or involved in officiating.
- Any other member of the Victorian lacrosse community with a genuine interest or involvement in officiating lacrosse.

Interested parties should be encouraged to contact the Secretary of ALRAV alravvic.secretary@gmail.com and express their interest in officiating at an ALA event, ideally around 3 months prior to the scheduled event.

Should several expressions of interest be received, the Executive of ALRAV shall determine their selection order on a merit basis.

Regardless of if single or multiple nominees received, the ALRAV Chief Referee will make the final selection of the recipient.
