Introduction

Welcome to Lacrosse Victoria's strategic plan for 2023-2027.

Lacrosse is one of the fastest-growing sports globally, and it is played in over 60 countries world-wide. In Victoria there are 15 clubs participating in state competitions in the winter season, and during the off-season players can take part in other formats of the game including Box and Sixes Lacrosse. Lacrosse caters for all ages and abilities, from those starting out to those competing in national and international competitions.

We enter the next phase of our strategic plan having emerged from nearly two years of COVID-19 lockdowns, welcoming all players, coaches, officials and volunteers back to the Lacrosse community.

In developing this plan, we surveyed our members and they've told us that we need to support and provide:

- More opportunities for off-season lacrosse (Autumn/ Summer)
- Improved club facilities- fields, club rooms, lighting
- Increased junior participation
- Marketing & promotion of the sport
- Support for coaches and officials

Over the next five years we want to substantially increase marketing and promotion, be more inclusive and offer programs that appeal to a broad cross-section of the community in a variety of formats. We want to ensure that everyone has the opportunity to participate in Lacrosse in such a way that matches their preferences.

We will work collaboratively with all of our participants, clubs, partners and stakeholders to make Lacrosse the best it can be for everyone involved.
