The U15 Girls Coaching Director will oversee the coaching program for Victoria's U15 Girls state teams participating in the Lacrosse Australia National Tournament. These teams will comprise players of mixed abilities. The Director will ensure consistent, inclusive, and developmentally appropriate coaching across all teams. This includes mentoring coaches, aligning training plans, and ensuring strong communication between coaching staff, team managers, and Lacrosse Victoria.

Key Responsibilities:

- Support and guide the coaches of all three Victorian U15 Girls teams.
- Promote inclusive, ability-aware coaching strategies that ensure all athletes thrive.
- Lead planning sessions and foster consistent messaging across the program.
- Mentor new and emerging coaches, helping them manage the demands of representative coaching.
- Ensure athlete wellbeing is prioritised through effective communication and planning.
- Coordinate with team managers to streamline operations and logistics.
- Provide a unified point of contact for Lacrosse Victoria, coaches, and parents
