

Spectator Behaviour Expectations

Lacrosse Victoria will not tolerate behaviour that is not in line with the Code of Conduct and expects all spectators, parents, and guardians to follow the LV Code of Conduct. The LV Code of Conduct can be found <u>HERE</u>



- Encourage children to participate within the rules
- Applaud good performances and efforts from all teams
- Refrain from any form of harassment, discrimination, or abuse
- Show respect for all teams, individual players, coaches, and officials
- Remember that children play organised sports for their own fun and enjoyment
- Recognise, appreciate, and respect the value and importance of volunteer coaches



- Encourage the use of violence in any form be it by spectators, coaches, officials, or players
- Ridicule or scold a child for making a mistake during a competition
- Force a child to participate if they are uninterested in doing so
- Teach children that overall outcome and victory is more important than putting in an honest effort
- Question an official's judgement and honesty in public
- Encourage the players to disregard the rules and officials decisions
